# STRATEGIC INITIATIVES BUDGET: 2009/2010 WARD-BASED COMMUNITY CHEST AND FINANCIAL UPDATE

## **Report of the Chief Executive**

## 1.0 Purpose of the Report

- 1.1 The purpose of this report is to bring forward 11 recommendations relating to the 2009/2010 Community Chest Scheme.
- **1.2** Annex 2 outlines expenditure from the Strategic Initiatives Budget and the Strategic Investment Plan.

## 2.0 Description of Decision

2.1 The Committee is requested to approve all 11 proposals for support from the 2009/10 Community Chest as detailed in Annex I.

### 3.0 Background

3.1 The Committee will be aware that the Community Chest forms part of the Strategic Initiatives Budget and that £250,000 is available for the scheme in 2009/2010, £10,000 for each Ward, plus any unclaimed allocations identified from previous years. This scheme is operated under Section 137 of the Local Government Act.
