1. Why has this report come to the Committee?

- 1.1 The Cabinet report on the draft guidance relating to new powers for councillors designed to help them solve problems in their wards is provided for further comment to Members of the Culture and Leisure Review Committee.

- 2.1 The report was presented to Cabinet on 11 March 2009 and looks at the new powers known as the Councillor Call for Action (CCfA).

3. Current position
