Governing Body Nominations

Power of Local Authority to Appoint Additional Governors

The Executive Director of Children's Services submitted a report requesting that additional governors be appointed to Hasting Hill Primary School.

Hasting Hill Primary School had been placed in Special Measures following an OFSTED inspection in March 2011 and the Local Authority had been given powers of intervention and powers to appoint additional Local Authority governors.

One additional governor had already been appointed but it was felt that to further strengthen the Governing Body, two additional governors should be nominated.

Upon consideration of the report, it was: -

13. RESOLVED that Elaine Matterson and Joan Cotcher be appointed to the Governing Body of Hasting Hill Primary School for an initial term of office of one year.

Power of LA to appoint additional governors - Education (Appointment of Governors) Panel – 12th December 2011

1. Hasting Hill Primary School

Following an OFSTED Inspection in March 2011, Hasting Hill Primary School was placed in Special Measures and under the Education Act 2002 (Part 4 Regulation 57), the Local Authority are given powers of intervention and the power to appoint additional Authority governors.

Three Additional Governors have already been appointed but it is felt that, in order to further strengthen the Governing Body, it is appropriate to appoint one further additional governor.

2. New Penshaw Primary School

This school was subject to an OFSTED inspection in October 2011 and the outcome was that the school was given a Notice to Improve. Using the same powers of intervention as described in the previous paragraph, it is proposed to strengthen the Governing Body by the appointment of one additional governor in the first instance.

3. Proposal

It is proposed that additional governors be appointed as detailed below and members are asked to consider this request.
