Reasons for this notice It appears to the Council that the breach of planning control has occurred within the last ten years.</p> <p>The enclosure and change of use of the land to private garden has resulted in the loss of open amenity space to the detriment of the visual amenities of the area. In addition, the realigned fence is an overbearing feature given its proximity to the public footpath. The fence also has the potential to create a tunnelling effect and reduce the commodiousness of the footpath to users. The development is contrary to policies B2 and B3 of the Council's adopted Unitary Development Plan, paragraph 2.4 (e) of the Supplementary Planning Guidance (2000) and topic 9.2 of the Supplementary Planning Document 'Household Alterations and Extensions' (2007). The Council do not consider that planning permission should be given, because planning conditions could not overcome these objections to the development.</p>	22/01/2009
