| Purpose of Report: This report requests Area Committee consideration of proposals for the allocation of Strategic Initiatives Budget (SIB) to support new initiatives that will benefit the area. | |
| Description of Decision: The Committee is requested to approve: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i) £30,000 from the 2008/09 budget to contribute to the refurbishment of the area in Hetton Town Centre known as the ‘mini park’ to create a Memorial Garden incorporating a sculptural footpath. ii) £10,000 from the 2008/08 budget to provide disabled access and toilets to St Oswalds Church Community Hall. iii) £1,350 from the 2008/09 budget to provide storage facilities for Penshaw Homing Society. iv) £19,000 from the 2008/09 budget to carry out a feasibility study to develop a sports and social facility on the site of New Herrington Working Men’s Club. v) £2,350 from the 2008/09 budget for EBC to deliver an event at Houghton Kepier School in order to develop partnership working with Poland around understanding and delivering the enterprise agenda. | |
