Cars have been damaged by being kicked and Scrakhod by people who were dronk and collecting more dronk from the store.

Thathing and highling were a regular occurrence which is a territying thing when you are at home on your own and there are two elderly neighbooks who also live next to me and I know thoug object and will also be writing about this matter.

within the vicinity thoe are two other outlets which sell alcohol and are ran to a high standard with no trade of all.

Henden Supplies are regular perits of rall for the fartice as there is always rouble around these shaps.

First social bohavior is a knew down problem which Sunderland City Covail and the boar police have to deal with an a daily basis, planse don't let this be the case here. There are plenty other uses that this empty isorperty can be put to a hair dressers, a gents barber shop an office for a property sales / letting agent. The property has only just come on the marker and internally is in a position where it could also be changed barber into a house egain.

Park Parade is within a conservation area and the frontage of this shop definitely does not fit in with the area surranding There is also a pub. The New Derby, which is now attracting alot of people to the area with no trouble being encantered at all.

This shop seems to attract all the wrong clientelle which take their drink to the Park or the sanfront areas along with the rubbish they loove behind.

By declining this application I strongly believe this will make a massive affect to the local area and keep trouble off our surranding streets. As this was definitely been the case which it has been closed.
