# 1. Purpose

# 2. Background

- 2.1 An invitation has been received from the Chartered Institute of Library and Information Professionals for a Conference entitled "Culture Connects". The Conference will take place 8-10 October 2008 at the Crown Plaza Hotel, Liverpool. A full itinerary for the conference is attached as Appendix 1 to this report.
