## **Health, Housing and Adult Services 15 Year Strategy – Update**

#### **1. PURPOSE OF REPORT**

- 1.1 To provide Members of Health and Wellbeing Scrutiny Committee with an update on the Directorate's 15 year Strategy and implementation of the 3 year delivery plan.

#### **2. BACKGROUND**

- 2.1 In 2008, HHAS developed their 15 year strategy, which set out the vision for adult social care based on the 5 outcomes:
  - Choice and Control
  - Independent Living
  - Equal Access for All
  - Improving Health and Wellbeing
  - Better Commissioning
- 2.2 In order to make a reality of the 15 year strategy, a 3 year delivery programme was developed, with the plan to establish a 3 year rolling programme of delivery.

#### **3. PRESENTATION**

- 3.1 The Executive Director of Health, Housing and Adult Services, along with the Portfolio Holder for Health and Wellbeing will deliver a presentation.
- 3.2 The presentation will focus on the successes of the first 3 year delivery plan, any outstanding actions and the recently developed next 3 year delivery plan.
- 3.3 The delivery plan for 2011/12 – 13/14 sets out a number of commissioning intentions, which will be shared through the presentation.
