- 1. Why has this report come to the Committee?
- 1.1 To consider the report of the Director of Development and Regeneration which will be considered by Cabinet on 5 November 2008.
- 1.2 To consider the proposed city wide Climate Change Action Plan for Sunderland which sets out a framework for reducing the city's greenhouse gas emissions between 2008 to 2022.

2. Background

- 2.1 On 6 June 2007, the Review Committee received and commented on an Issues and Options Consultation Paper on Developing a Climate Change Action Plan for Sunderland. This was part of an extensive consultation process used to develop the Plan.
- 2.2 The Climate Change Action Plan will be considered by Cabinet on 5 November 2008.
- 2.3 The Cabinet is recommended to:
 - i. adopt the Climate Change Action Plan;
 - ii. endorse the Council's adoption of the EUROCITIES Declaration on Climate Change;
 - iii. release £20,000 of Strategic Investment Plan funding to support projects within the Sustainable City Programme
