1. Property Crime (Including Burglary and Car Crime)

- 1.1 No issues reported to LMAPS for this reporting period.

2. Anti-Social Behaviour (Including alcohol related crime and disorder and Criminal Damage)

- 2.1 ASB activity in vicinity of Silksworth Ski Slope. Issues reported to LMAPS since May 07.

Latest action – LMAPS continuing to explore CCTV as an option. Planning has been agreed. Meeting to discuss financial considerations pending.

- 2.2 ASB activity in Newport area. Issues reported to LMAPS since October 07.

Latest Action – Landlord of property had served an eviction notice which has resulted in several anti-social residents moving out of the area. However one resident still residing at the address. Police will continue to monitor the situation. Site meeting to be arranged with local residents to ascertain next steps.

- 2.3 ASB motorcycling activity reported in the vicinity of Doxford International/ Burdon Road, plus reports of usage of air guns. Issues reported to LMAPS at March 08 meeting.

Latest Action – This was considered to be a Police only issue. Closed from LMAPS at March meeting.

- 2.4 Reports in local press of ASB in several streets on Tunstall Estate. Issues reported to LMAPS at March 08 meeting.

Latest Action – It was reported that Police are aware of the problem and consider it a low level nuisance. However several ABAs had been served and incidents had reduced. Closed from LMAPS at April meeting.

6. Any Other Business

6.1 Targeted Youth Engagement - Latest update from April 08

Whilst the project was due to end in March, a further six months funding has been agreed from the Working Neighbourhood Fund to extend the project until September.

6.2 Doxford Park - Parking problems

This has appeared as a long standing issue on LMAPS. Options to resolve issues continue to be explored. Police will continue with resource intensive monitoring/ enforcement.

6.3 Marketing

Marketing campaign to promote the work carried out by LMAPS continues to receive positive feedback.

6.4 Funding

As at the April meeting there was still no feedback as to the future availability of LMAPS funding.

6.5 Tyne and Wear Fire and Rescue Service (TWFRS)

It was reported at the March meeting that a substantial number of secondary fires had taken place in the area. Local schools were to be visited by Police and TWFRS.

6.6 Weeks of Action

It was reported at the March meeting that Estate Walkabouts were planned for April to involve all partners.

6.7 Plains Farm

It was reported to the March meeting that research had been undertaken on the estate, results of which would be fed back to LMAPS in due course. Home Housing expressed thanks to Police PC 1161 for the results he has achieved on the estate and described him as an example of excellent policing

6.8 Selective Licensing

A presentation was provided to the March meeting on Selective Licensing of landlords in designated areas.

6.9 Common Assessment Framework (CAF)

A presentation was provided to the April meeting on the CAF by which young people's needs will be assessed.

It was reported to the April meeting that a new report format would be introduced for LMAPS reports to the Area Committee.
