by establishing a 16-place resourced Special Educational Needs Unit with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> September 2024. The Unit established will provide for special educational needs associated with Autism. This will be based at and managed by Mill Hill Primary School.

Mill Hill Primary School is a Primary School maintained by Sunderland City Council.
