#### **Purpose of Report:**

This report requests Area Committee consideration of proposals for the allocation of Strategic Initiatives Budget (SIB) to support new initiatives that will benefit the area.

#### **Description of Decision:**

The Committee is requested to approve the following:

- i) £1,562 from the 2008/9 budget as a contribution to 'Dance Mobility for Children with Disabilities' project;
- ii) £2,500 from the 2008/9 budget as a contribution to the 'Seated Exercise and Mature Moves' project;
- £7,000 from the 2008/9 budget as a contribution to the Silksworth Park Bowling Club's 'Automated Irrigation Scheme' project;
- iv) £10,000 from the 2008/9 and £20,000 from the 2009/10 budget, subject to budget approval, as a contribution to the 'Job Start Mentoring' project;
- v) £7,600 from the 2008/9 budget as a contribution to the 'Plains Farm and Humbledon Service Development' project;
- vi) £9,998 from the 2008/9 budget as a contribution to the 'Promoting Youth Initiatives' project.
