

RE: Application for a premises licence, Corner Flag, High Street West, Sunderland.

Northumbria Police are in receipt of the above application and wish to object on the grounds of crime and disorder, however these objections will be withdrawn should the applicant agree to have the following conditions attached to the premises licence;

1. A CCTV system must be designed, installed and maintained in proper working order, to the satisfaction of the Council and Northumbria Police. Such a system must:
 - Ensure coverage of all entrances and exits to the premises internally and externally;
 - Ensure coverage of such other areas as may be required by the Council or Northumbria Police;
 - Provide continuous recording facilities for each camera to a good standard of clarity. Such recordings must be retained for a minimum period of 28 days, and must be supplied to an Officer of the Council or Northumbria Police Staff/Officer on request;
 - Must be in operation at all times the premises are in use.
2. No patrons must be allowed to leave the premises whilst in the possession of any drinking vessel or open bottle, whether empty or containing any beverage.
3. All members of staff at the premises including Door Supervisors shall seek credible photographic proof of age evidence from any person who appears to be under the age of 21 years, and who is seeking access to the premises or is seeking to purchase or consume alcohol on the premises. Such credible evidence, which shall include a photograph of the customer, will either be a passport, photographic driving licence, or a Proof of Age card carrying a 'PASS' logo.
4. The licensee and Designated Premises Supervisor must ensure that on Friday, Saturday, Sunday proceeding a Bank Holiday and Monday evenings, between 2130hrs until closing, there are employed at the premises a minimum of 2 SIA Door Supervisors.

5. The licensee shall ensure that on each day that Door Supervisors are engaged for duty at the premises, their details (full name, D.O.B. and licence number) are recorded in an appropriate book kept at the premises. In conjunction with this book, the licensee shall also keep an incident book. This record book and incident book must be available for inspection by Northumbria Police or Officers of the Council at all times the premises are open.
6. When informed by Northumbria Police of a high risk football match the premises must ensure that only plastic or polycarbonate drinkware is used in the premises, with no glass bottle sales over the counter, an appropriate number of door supervisors are to be employed with agreement of Northumbria Police.
7. There must be provided at the premises text and/or radio equipment maintained in good working order, to be operated in conjunction with the Police.
8. The licensee and/or Designated Premises Supervisor shall be a member of the local pubwatch scheme and attend the pubwatch meetings on a regular basis.
9. Sale of alcohol every day 0900-0300hrs, late night refreshment 2300-0300hrs, all other licensable activities 0800-0300hrs, opening hours of the premises 0800-0330hrs.
