1. Purpose of Report

- 1.1 The purpose of this report is to provide members with the outcome of the Public Consultation seeking views on Options and Locations and the subsequent Option Evaluation process concerning PRIDE (Providing Improved Mental Health and Learning Disability Environments in Sunderland and South Tyneside.)

2. Background

- 2.1 Northumberland, Tyne and Wear NHS Foundation Trust has been working with health service commissioners to consider plans for new in-patient accommodation in Sunderland and South Tyneside, to facilitate modern approaches to mental health treatment and care.
- 2.2 A short-list of four options was agreed and formal public consultation sought the views from service users and their carers; from staff and from the general public. The consultation period ran from 21 September 2009 to 31 December 2009
