#### 1 INTRODUCTION

1.1 The Fire and Rescue 2008 conference is scheduled to take place at the New Arena and Convention Centre, Liverpool, from 27<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> August 2008.

## 2 BACKGROUND TO THE FIRE AND RESCUE CONFERENCE

- 2.1 The conference is an annual event, which provides the opportunity for everyone within the Fire and Rescue Sector to meet and receive current information relating to National Fire Service issues. To this end, Fire and Rescue 2008 will be highlighting a number of key issues, including operational doctrine, flooding and the environment, health and safety, comprehensive area assessments, fire insurance and equality ands diversity. The main plenary sessions will be supported by a programme of topical and practical workshops covering new technology, skills and competency framework, industrial relations, national standards and post fire business continuity.
- 2.2 In addition to the above, there will also be an opportunity to view the Emergency Action Zone, where the very best fire fighting and rescue equipment and techniques will be shown in a series of demonstrations and the conference will run alongside the tenth World Firefighter Games, also being held in Liverpool. It is envisaged that the Minister for Fire will also be addressing the conference.

3.1 In order that provisional arrangements can be made, it is proposed that the Chairman and the Vice-Chairman represent the Authority at the Fire and Rescue Conference.
