

CIVIL PARKING ENFORCEMENT – OPTIONS FOR SERVICE DELIVERY

REPORT OF THE CITY SOLICITOR

1. Why has this report come to the Committee?

- 1.1 To consider the report of the Director of Development and Regeneration which will be considered by Cabinet on 5 November 2008.
- 1.2 To monitor the progress being made in relation to parking services and parking enforcement.

2. Background

- 2.1 On 5 November 2008, the Cabinet will consider a report on the termination of the off street parking enforcement contract with NCP Services associated with Civil Parking Enforcement (CPE) and the proposal that the service be provided in house.
- 2.2 The Cabinet is recommended to:-
 - i. note the termination date of NCP Services off street parking enforcement contract of 2 February 2010;
 - ii. approve the option to provide Civil Parking Enforcement as an in house delivered services from 3 February 2010;
 - iii. authorise the Director of Development and Regeneration and the City Solicitor to take the appropriate action.
