Why are there plans to close it? We should be celebrating the achievements of this school! Holding it up as a model for other small schools. Why fix something that is not broken?

The surplus places problem can be resolved at Gillas Lane. ~~It~~ So why should Gillas Lane Primary School have to pay to sort out the problems at Bernard Gilpin and, now we gather, Houghton Nursery? It seems very unfair on the teachers, the pupils, the parent and carers and the larger community of Gillas Lane.

It also seems very unfair that Gillas Lane is being treated very differently to other schools with even larger surplus problems. Take the situation at Grange Park in the Monkwearmouth cluster. According to the school place planning report, the option appraised pointed to the closure of Grange Park. However, because of the uncertainty surrounding the cluster, not only was Grange Park given a reprieve but the proposal was to reduce the PAN and remodel the school to net capacity. The situation would be monitored over the next three years. Surely, Gillas Lane should be treated like Grange Park at the very least in view of the uncertainty about population projections and rates of housebuilding over the next 5-10 years.

Why has education not been a factor in this highly contentious decision? Should we not be looking to maintain and raise standards of education? Gillas Lane is doing that. There is no guarantee that the ~~levels~~ ^{standards} currently achieved at Gillas Lane will be achieved at Bernard Gilpin following amalgamation. The teachers who helped to achieve these standards will be displaced and the school/ community partnership will have been ripped apart.


