# STRATEGIC INITIATIVES BUDGET: 2008/2009 WARD-BASED COMMUNITY CHEST

## Report of the Chief Executive (Acting)

## 1.0 Purpose of the Report

**1.1** The purpose of this report is to bring forward 11 recommendations relating to the 2008/2009 Community Chest Scheme.

## 2.0 Description of Decision

# 3.0 Background

3.1 The Committee will be aware that the Community Chest forms part of the Strategic Initiatives Budget and that £250,000 is available for the scheme in 2008/2009, £10,000 for each Ward, plus any unclaimed allocations identified from previous years. This scheme is operated under Section 137 of the Local Government Act.
