**08/03391/FUL – Change of use of existing terraced house to ground floor café/hot food takeaway with self-contained residential flat at first floor level and installation of shop front, 89 High Street, Easington Lane, Houghton-le-Spring, DH5 0JR**

The representative of the Director of Development and Regeneration presented the item highlighting the proposal, relevant planning policies and considerations and an analysis of objections received with particular reference to concerns over odour, residential amenity noise, parking issues and traffic congestion.

Mr. Finnigan, objector spoke with regard to the planning application highlighting the:-

- noise levels would be disturbing due to vibrations emitted from the machinery and customers coming and going into the evening;
- his and his family's personal lives would be effected due to such close proximity to their home; and
- an increase in car parking to the front.

Consideration having been given to the application as detailed in the report of the Director of Development and Regeneration, it was:-
