EARLY HELP DIRECTORATE ANNUAL REPORT 2021/22

1. Purpose of the Report

- 1.1 To consider the Early Help Directorate Annual Report for 2021/22 and the operation of the service.

2. Background

- 2.1 In setting its work programme for the year, the Committee agreed to receive an update on the work of the Early Help Service, together with an update on Family Hubs.
- 2.2 The current Early Help Directorate was established on 1 April 2017, to replace the previous arrangements which were known as 'Strengthening Families'.
- 2.3 The Directorate also has responsibility for the Youth Offending Service, Targeted Youth Services, Prevention and Innovation services which include Participation and Engagement, Family Group Conferencing and Relationships, Sex and Health Education (RSHE). More recently, responsibility for the Government's Holiday Activity and Food (HAF) programme has been added to the areas of responsibility.
