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**1 INTRODUCTION**

- 1.1 At its meeting on 5<sup>th</sup> November, the Authority considered a report on the IRMP – Review of How We Respond Relative to Risk and approved the commencement of a consultation process in respect of the options set out in the report. This report provides members with an update to that report.

**2 BACKGROUND**

- 2.1 It has come to officers' attention that the previous report contained a calculation error in *Figure 3*, which set out the average number of incidents by station and risk level over the last five years. Unfortunately, the figures given in the 'Grand Total' column were incorrect due to formula error in that column. All other data in the table is correct.

**3 UPDATED FIGURE 3**

- 3.1 A revised Figure 3, with the corrected grand totals, is set out below. Members are reassured that the error highlighted has no material impact on the outcomes or proposals set out by the review that were the subject of the earlier report. Any representations received during the consultation process regarding the relevance of the average number of incidents, will of course be reported to the Authority when it is considering the consultation responses.
