Peter Noble, a resident of Sunderland, has submitted the following question to be put to the Council meeting on 15 September 2021.

"Ayton children's park within Washington South was replaced last year, funded by Section 106 monies. Sunderland Council took a charge of almost £9k professional fees including design, but no drainage was installed, nor a suitable ground surface, resulting in the park being unusable within months. Tax payers have since funded £10k to rectify the original work.

Has the council recouped this cost from the contractor, who Cllr Miller has publicly blamed for the poor quality of original work?".
