The Representative of the Director of Development and Regeneration advised that an objection had been received from a neighbour. This objection had centred on the overshadowing and loss of sunlight caused by the development, the reduction in privacy and the disturbances which would be caused during the works. It was considered that these concerns were not sufficient to refuse planning permission and that the impact of the extension on the living conditions of the neighbouring

dwelling was considered to be minimal. The boundary fencing would prevent any loss of privacy. It was not considered that disturbances during construction would be grounds for refusal as any disturbance would be during normal working hours.
