# STRATEGIC INITIATIVES BUDGET: 2009/2010 WARD-BASED COMMUNITY CHEST AND FINANCIAL UPDATE

#### Report of the Director of Development and Regeneration

## 1.0 Purpose of the Report

- 1.1 The purpose of this report is to bring forward 20 recommendations relating to the 2009/2010 Community Chest Scheme.

## 2.0 Description of Decision

3.1 The Committee will be aware that the Community Chest forms part of the Strategic Initiatives Budget and that £250,000 is available for the scheme in 2009/2010, £10,000 for each Ward, plus any unclaimed allocations identified from previous years. This scheme is operated under Section 137 of the Local Government Act.
