FREEDOM OF THE CITY – MR. JAMES MONTGOMERY BEM AND MR. JOHN HAYS

Joint report of the Chief Executive and Head of Law and Governance

At its meeting on 23 March 2016 the Council agreed to the conferring of the Honorary Freedom of the City upon Mr. James Montgomery BEM and Mr. John Hays and that an Extraordinary Meeting of the Council be convened at which to hold the formal ceremony.

The Council is, therefore, invited to formally confer the Honorary Freedom of the City upon Mr. James Montgomery BEM and Mr. John Hays by passing the following resolutions; namely:-
