Purpose of Report:

This report requests Area Committee consideration of proposals for the allocation of Strategic Initiatives Budget (SIB) to support a variety of new initiatives that will benefit the area.

Description of Decision:

The Committee is requested to approve the following from the 2007/8 budget:

- i) £29,865 as a contribution from the 2008/9 budget for Washington Victim Support Project
- ii) £14,000 as a contribution from the 2008/9 budget for the Tumble Track Project
- £5,000 as a contribution from the 2008/9 budget for the multi-area bid Mature Moves
- iv) £4,500 as a contribution from the 2008/9 budget for the Green Start project
- v) £20,000 as a contribution from the 2008/9 budget for the North Washington YIP Parenting Pilot
- vi) £9,500 as a contribution from the 2008/9 budget for a Washington Town Library Youth Liaison Officer
- vii) £7,810 as a contribution from the 2008/9 budget for the multi-area project Dance for Children with Mobility issues
