We are writing to you to register our objection to the application for an alcohol license By Sainsbury's PLC at the above address. The basis for the opposition is that granting a license for these premises will not promote the licensing objectives, particularly the prevention of crime disorder and antisocial behaviour.

This site is within fee of residential properties, at the entrance to a quiet cul-de-sac and also within yards of a Junior School. The impact of the proposed licensing hours, i.e., 7am to 11pm, 7 days a week would be enormous. It is totally unacceptable to expect people in the area and schoolchildren to have to put up with the results which would be:

- Antisocial behaviour problems, especially late at night, 7days a week. The surrounding area being used as a toilet for all and sundry.
- 2) Litter problems, bottles, cans etc being left.
- Residents being afraid to enter and leave the street (Broadstairs Court) especially at night with such problems as above.
- 4) The street already suffers to some degree from the above problems from the 4 licensed premises already in the area (within a few hundred metres of the proposed site)

In view of the above , I would urge the Licensing Authority to refuse the application.
