
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


























- Self-harm is an expression of personal distress and there are many reasons why someone may harm themselves

- Self-halm is often lepeated around 20% of people who self-
- High risk group for suicide at least half of people who die by suicide who ve self-harmed at some point, often shortly before
- The risk of suicide following self-harm is 60-100 times greater than the risk in the general population in the first 12 month
- Suicide audit 42% had self-harmed previously

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What does the data tell us?
