Government Policy and Guidance

- "The family is the bedrock of society.
- Nothing shall be done to remove from parents their responsibility to their child.
- It is in the national interest to help parents meet these responsibilities."



Parenting Support provided at 3 levels

- For parents who are experiencing significant problems.
- Where parents want or need additional support
- All parents early access to advise and support in a wide range of local settings and times.



Parenting Support provided for 4 age bands

- Pre-birth
- 0-5 years
- 5-11 years
- 11-18 years
