1 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 The Council Leaders and Elected Mayor of the seven North East councils have agreed in principle to a devolution deal, which the Government has confirmed it is 'minded to' approve.
- 1.2 The devolution proposals are currently out for public consultation across the region with a closing date of 23 March for any responses. On the 20 February 2023 the Service receive a letter on behalf of the seven councils involved in the devolution proposals inviting them to review the proposals and if minded to do so, offer a letter of support (Appendix 1).
