

## **Analysis of SACRE members Survey 2023**

### **Venue**

There was an even split between Bunnyhill and City Hall, one person indicated a slight preference for Bunnyhill in terms of ease of access. When other venue was opted for then a virtual meeting was requested.

### **Time and day**

Overwhelming day for meeting was Tuesday with Monday being the only other day opted for. Most respondents indicated the current meeting time of 4.30-6.30 as the best and 3-5pm the second most popular.

### **Additional Work**

When asked if they were willing to do additional work to facilitate SACRE meetings with one exception all identified areas they would help with. The most popular sections being "Doing a school visit" and "being part of a small working party".

### **NASACRE**

The majority of SACRE members access the NASACRE website at some point. Very few members have attended the free virtual training offered by NASACRE.

### **Development Areas**

The following areas of development were highlighted:

- Collective worship monitoring.

- A formalised agenda group including Chair, VC, Officers, and others to keep the agenda on the move between meetings coaching and helping RE leads within schools. Helping with the collective worship action point on the SACRE action plan
- Making Schools aware of Judaism
- Interfaith work
- Other Denominations. Becoming Members
- The enforcement of teaching RE adequately in schools
- Working groups for specific tasks/projects might enable greater collaborative work.
- Apply for a Westhill award as a focus for our work with regard to making the work of SACRE more diverse.
