The Council has identified that additional primary school paces will be needed to meet the infrastructure requirements of the South Sunderland Growth Area (SSGA). It has been proposed that these requirements are met through the expansion of two existing primary schools and the future development of a new 315 place primary school. St Paul's CE VC Primary School has been identified as one of the two existing schools to be expanded in order to increase the supply of primary school places in the area.

Reasons for decision:

Willow Fields Primary School is currently over capacity in 3 of 7 year groups. The current school has neither the capacity nor additional support resources to support this ongoing oversubscription.

The current building has insufficient physical capacity to provide 1 classroom per form of entry, with 5 general class bases for 7 year groups. The proposed expansion of the school will provide sufficient class bases and supporting areas for both a 210 and a 315 place school.

New housing proposals in the North Sunderland area will place pressure on the sufficiency of existing school places. Within statutory walking distance of the new Willow Field Primary School site at Redcar Road (as detailed below) there are proposals for in excess of 900 new homes. This level of housing development is estimated to require over 210 school places, the equivalent of a new primary school.

The proposal to increase the capacity of Willow Fields Primary School is associated with the already approved proposal to relocate the school to a new building at the former Maplewood School site at Redcar Road in North Sunderland. This proposal was approved by Sunderland City Council's Cabinet in March 2019. The proposal which is the subject of this decision record is to increase the physical capacity of the new build by 175 places over those currently available within the school's current buildings in order to meet demand for places in the area.

• Retain existing Willow Fields capacity of 140 places at existing site

 Relocate Willow Fields Primary School with existing capacity of 140 places (See full outline in report in link below.)
