I am a alcoholic and drug addict in recovery for the past 8 months. I have attended oak trees rehab at Washington from September to December 2020.

When I moved into the property the shop was vacant and was formally a butcher. I intentionally looked for a safe environment fir myself and my daughter to live in. My definition of safe is away from a community which is known for alcohol and drug use.

I have real concerns over living directly next to a premises that sells alcohol due to the proximity of alcohol sakes, the customer traffic and the risk of increased noise level and anti social behaviour that may occur due to the opening of this establishment.

I fear for my daughters and my own well-being if this application. Is granted. There is an off licence less than half a mile away north of the application so I do not feel this is essential for any community growth.
