Notice is hereby given in accordance with Section 19 of the Education and Inspections Act 2006, that it is the intention of Sunderland City Council, City Hall, Plater Way, Sunderland SR1 3AA to:

Lower the age range of Thorney Close Primary School Torquay Road, Sunderland, SR3 4BB from 3 – 11 years of age to 2 – 11 years of age with effect from 1st January 2023.

Thorney Close Primary School is a maintained primary school maintained by Sunderland City Council.

The current school building offers a nursery provision for children aged 3 and above. This proposal will result in a nursery provision for 2, 3 and 4-year-old children.
