1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To provide Members of Health and Wellbeing Scrutiny Committee with an update on the Directorate's 15 year Strategy and implementation of the 3 year delivery plan.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 In 2008, HHAS developed their 15 year strategy, which set out the vision for adult social care based on the 5 outcomes:
 - Choice and Control
 - Independent Living
 - Equal Access for All
 - Improving Health and Wellbeing
 - Better Commissioning
- 2.2 In order to make a reality of the 15 year strategy, a 3 year delivery programme was developed, with the plan to establish a 3 year rolling programme of delivery.
