- 01.05.07 A report was submitted to Insp. LM by Bob Bertram of the Council's traffic department
- It has been proposed that signage will be put in place, on some spots it will be NO PARKING at anytime and others will be NO PARKING between 10.00am to 11.00am and 3.00pm to 4.00pm to coincide with shift patterns at Doxford International but allowing residents to park outside their homes. It will then be up to the Police to monitor and enforce these restrictions.
- Insp. LM informed the group that residents had taken it upon themselves to put flyers on windscreens and this was having some impact although she said she wouldn't endorse this practice.
- 05.06.07 Sqt SL informed the group the Council was progressing with restrictions and signage. Police to continue to Police area, all agreed to remain on LMAPS until matter is resolved.
- 10.07.07 Insp LM informed the group that due to other priorities she has been informed by Bob Bertram that residents are still to be canvassed although he assured her letters have been sent to St Chad's Councillors, Coun Tye suggested Doxford Park Councillors should also have been informed but as far as he was aware they hadn't.
- Alan Mitchell suggested he be sent paperwork and he would raise it with Phil Spooner.

#### Actions

- Insp LM to send e-mail to Alan Mitchell from Bob Bertram
- Alan Mitchell to speak to Phil Spooner
- Coun Tye to discover if Doxford Park Councillors have received letters.
- 14.08.07 Insp LM informed the group that little or no progress had been made even though she was assured that the process would take 6 months she has since been advised other priorities had delayed the process. Whilst the group understand the inevitable delays - Insp LM believes the residents deserve a more positive response, the residents had yet to receive any notification re proposed plans. Also Bob Bertram was to update Insp LM on a 5 weekly basis to enable LMAPS to be kept informed.

Action - Kelly Henderson to find out any progress achieved; if residents had received a notification of proposal and speak to Bob Bertram re regular updates to Insp LM - and report back to Insp LM.

# AOB and info sharing

- 18.09.07 AM reported that the order should be in place by October. Cllr Tye reported that whilst St Chad's councillors had received notification councillors for Doxford ward had not. AM to ask Craig Wilkinson to copy Cllr Tye into any correspondence.
- Sgt SL reported a number of parked cars along Camberwell Way had been 'keyed' CSO's are patrolling the area and notices have been sent to Offices at Doxford International.
- 23.10.07 Insp LM informed the group reports had increased ranging from residents tolerance, to obstruction and criminal damage to vehicles. Discussions took place to identify ways to progress with the problem as it was suggested the process would only take 6mnths, various solutions were addressed including park and ride scheme using the Ski Slopes overspill car park; residents only parking; promoting car sharing and giving priority parking spaces to those who do.

It was agreed parking issues be raised to director level as the problem is becoming even more troublesome to the local residents.

#### **Vulnerable properties**

• KL had been asked by Ian Gicquel of T & W Fire & Rescue Arson Task Force to point out to all LMAPS vulnerable properties which have been targeted repeatedly by youths, he asked what partner agencies could do to help alleviate this problem as it impacts on resources and finances. Only one property highlighted at LMAPS – South which is vacant and has been targeted several times. It was agreed to ascertain ownership of the building and surrounding land with the view of clearing and securing the area.

**Action** – IR to discover ownership.

• 05.06.07 - IR informed the group of the owners and is earmarked for the development of a number of executive homes. All utilities have been disconnected and the property boarded-up. A meeting between the Owners; Planners and Developers is to be held 14.06.07 to finalise details as there is some hold-up due to trees being subject to a protection order.

Action - will forward details of ownership to KL.

- 10.07.07 A meeting on the 14.06.07 took place although there are still problems to address. Ian has liaised with Sgt SL.
   Monitor and update at next meeting.
- 14.08.07 Ian Gicquel informed the group that little or nothing had been done to the Public House with access to the property easier than ever, there is also evidence of asbestos in the building. There is also evidence of it being used for alcohol and drug taking activities.
  Cllr Tye informed group the planning application had been submitted but there is an ongoing issue with the trees which were removed.

Action – Kelly Henderson to speak to Barry Coe re either demolition of securing the property.

Karen Lindsay to speak to lan Richardson's team re clearing debris.

- 18.09.07 AM informed the group a hearing is to take place re demolition of the Public House on 24.09.07. PI reported that some private documents were recovered from a recent fire at the property which could identify the fly-tippers he passed documents to Sgt SL.
- 23.10.07— Cllr Tye informed the group notice had been served on the current owner, however it is anticipated the sale of the land will be approx 15.11.07 whereupon the new owner will need to be served; the onus is on the landowner to clear site.
  PI reported 3 incidents had been recorded recently and due to the dangerous state of the building was now an bigger risk to trespassers' with the

discovery of asbestos.

- PI reported there had been 9 incidents near the mineral line all around 3pm which resulted in appliances being tied up for lengthy periods. AM reported that the area in question could be part of the conservation / reclamation area and will liaise with Andy Old to confirm this. Sgt SL reported they are aware of the times and had deployed CSO's to step up patrols. PI to liaise with the local School to attempt to identify absent students at the times / dates of the incidents.
- 23.10.07 PI reported a fall in incidents in the area of the mineral line due to increased Police presence, however he requested it remain on LMAPS due to forthcoming bonfire night. Continue to monitor for 1mth.

#### Warwick Garage

- Ian Gicquel informed the group that the Fire & Rescue Service were called to the site twice for malicious fires in unsecured containers, there is not only the risk of fire setting activities there is also the potential for someone to be trapped in the containers. On visiting the site he also anticipated problems of site access.
- 18.09.07 Demolition is in progress and CSO's have increased patrols.
- 23.10.07- Sgt PD reported paint left behind by developers had been used to graffiti surrounding walls; steps are ongoing to id perpetrators. Sgt PD to instruct the developers to remove paint and any other debris from the site.
   All agreed to close from LMAPS.

#### **Marketing**

- 18.09.07 Jack Saward asked the group for ideas as to how to spend LMAPS funding, all agreed to discuss at the next LMAPS.
   Cllr Tye suggested making use of the advertising hoardings on the approach to Silksworth to highlight what youth provision is available in the area and promote good news in the area.
- Action AM to invite Jane Gatiss or Norman Tween from marketing group to next LMAPS.
  - 23.10.07 Jane Gatiss explained some funding has become available which will finance a City-wide marketing campaign to address fear of crime. She advised the contract will be awarded shortly and suggested it may prove impractical to commit funding from LMAPS for billboards at this stage. Jane Gatiss to return to LMAPS to update on the focus of the campaign.

All are welcome to partake in the event and JF will update at next LMAPS.
All the group agreed to support the bid.

Cllr Tye reported a similar event is to be held at Plains Farm through Neighbourhood Watch – Insp LM and the group raised concerns that Plains Farm appear to work in isolation.

### TYE proposal

23.10.07 - SG informed the group the Juvenile Serv are to design a card with all diversionary activities for Police and CSO's to issue to youngsters and suggested that LMAPS funds could be used to finance the project, at a cost of £250.
All the group agreed to support the bid.
