FOSTERING RECRUITMENT UPDATE

Report of the Director of Children's Social Care, Together for Children

1. Purpose of the Report

To update Corporate Parenting Board on recruitment activity within Together for Children Fostering Sunderland.

2. Introduction/Background

Following a comprehensive review and consultation period a new Training, Support and Fee Scheme was implemented on the 1st April 2019 with a view to improving the recruitment and retention of Foster Carers.

3. Recruitment

In the year ending March 2018 Together for Children approved 7 mainstream foster carers within the previous 12 months.

In the year ending March 2019 Together for Children approved 6 mainstream foster carers within the previous 12 months.

In the period April – Sep 2019 Together for Children have so far recruited 7 mainstream foster carers, evidencing a considerable increase in recruitment.




4. Retention

In the year ending March 2018 Together for Children had considered 22 resignations and 5 de-registrations (as a result of Standards of Care concerns).

In the year ending March 2019 Together for Children had considered 21 resignations and 2 de-registrations.

In the period April – September 2019 Together for Children have considered 7 resignations and 2 de-registrations thus showing are increased retention rate.
