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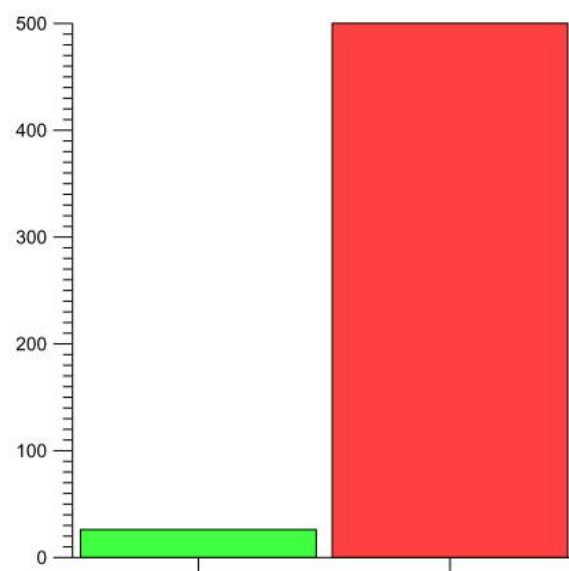

Do you agree with the proposal?



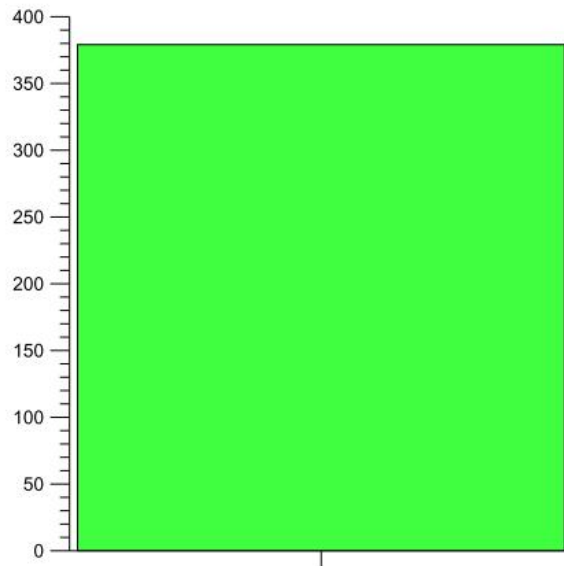

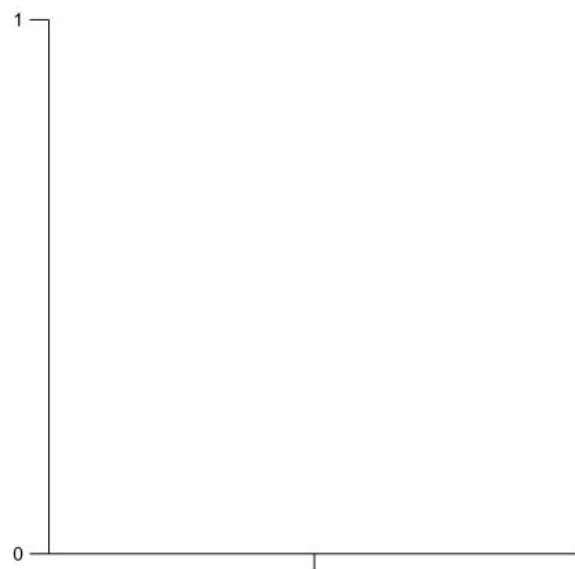

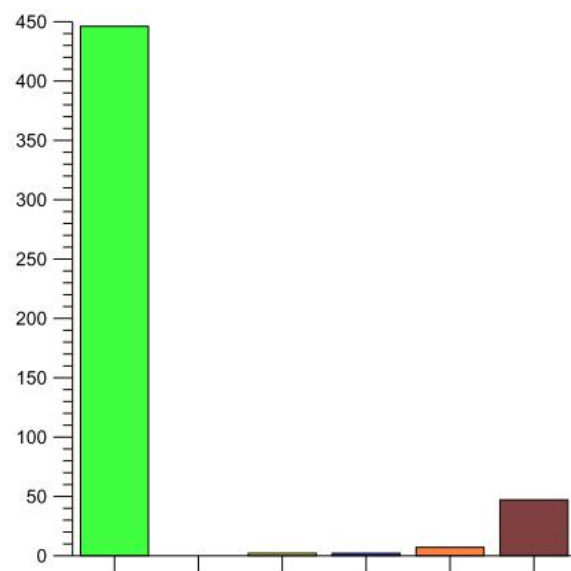

How would you define your sexual orientation?

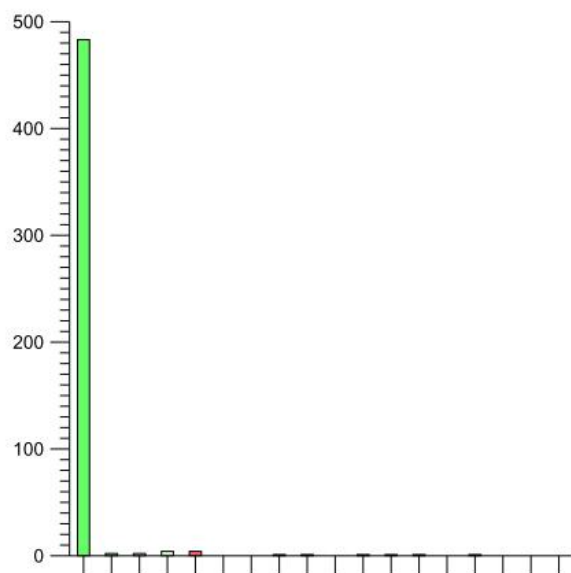

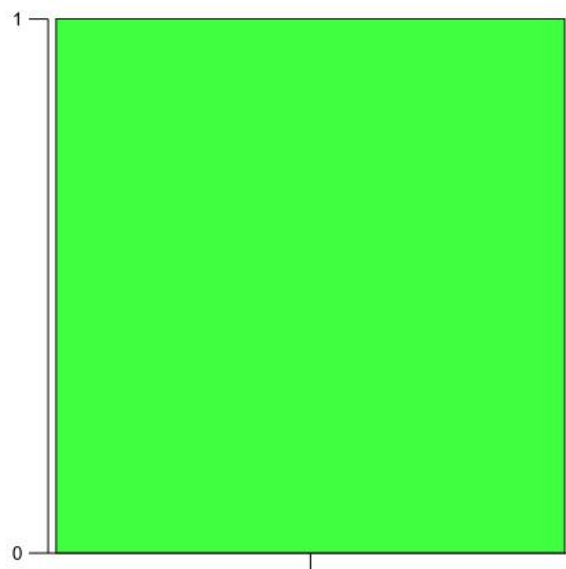

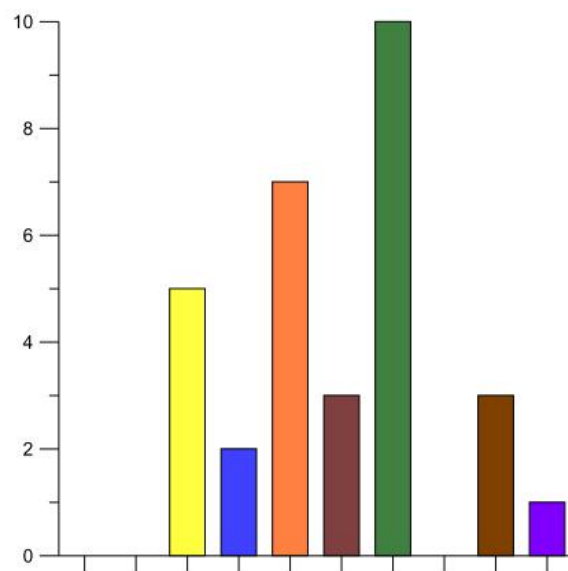

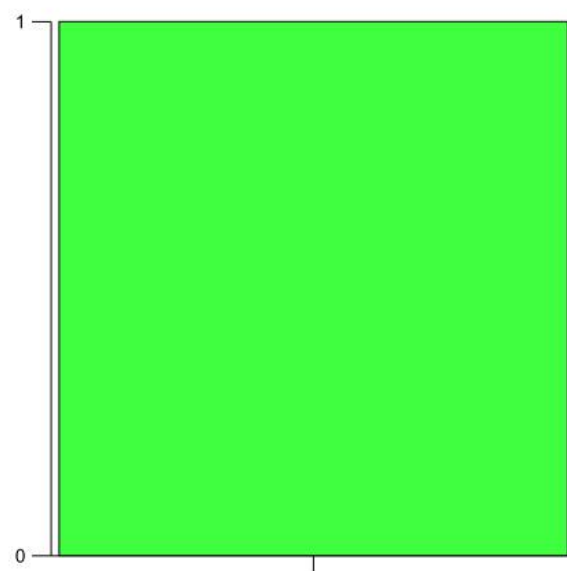
