Current position on work programme items	
Accessibility across the city	A report was scheduled to come to the Committee in December 21, however there has been a delay and the report will now be submitted for January 22 meeting.
Impact of Decent Homes Standard	The Committee is to receive an update/overview on the work taking place across the sector on

	this issue and in particular around the health impacts from housing conditions.
GP Access in Sunderland	Sunderland CCG are to undertake a similar review and would mean duplicating work already taking place. However, there are opportunities to be involved in this piece of work including; Membership on the CCG's Project Group; Workshop with the Committee as part of the review; Updates and outcomes of the review will be presented at future committee meetings.
