Strategic Initiative Budget (SIB) Financial Statement and Proposals for further allocation of Resources

1. Purpose of the Report

1.1 Area Committee has delegated budgets to allocate to specific strategic priorities identified in the Local Area Plan and work plan, with the overall aim to benefit the wider community and to attract other funding into the area. The report provides a financial statement as an up date position on progress in relation to allocating SIB.

2. Strategic Initiatives Budget (SIB)

2.1. The table below show the financial position of SIB following the January 2013 meeting.

- 2.2 Following the January 2013 Area Committee meeting, a balance of £460,582 SIB remains to be allocated from the 2012/13 budget.
- 2.3 In February 2013 and March 2013, West Area Place Board discussed the Highway Maintenance Programme 2013/14.
- 2.4 Information detailing the works to be carried out will be presented on the night of Committee and are attached at **Annex 1**. The Place Board is recommending that £71,250 of the SIB 2012/13 budget is aligned against the Highway Maintenance Programme (subject to delegated decision by the Portfolio Holder and Head of Street Scene).
- 2.5 If members agree to align £71,250 against the programme, £389,332 SIB would remain to be allocated during 2012/13, with one meeting remaining.

- (b) Agree to align £71,250 2012/13 SIB (subject to delegated decision by the Portfolio Holder and Head of Street Scene) against the prioritised list of works in the Highways Maintenance Programme 2013/14, attached at **Annex 1**.
