

TRAVEL AND TRANSPORT IMPACT REVIEW OVERVIEW

REPORT OF INTEGRATED TRANSPORT PLANNING LIMITED

1. PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

- 1.1 The report provides a summary of the independent review of transport and travel issues relating to options being proposed in the Path to Excellence public consultation starting in July 2017.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 The travel and transport impact review public consultation document is attached at **Appendix 1** of this report and sets out summary of options proposed as part of the Path to Excellence public consultation July 2017.
- 2.2 Also attached at **Appendix 2** is the Travel and Transport Impact Assessment for Clinical Service Reviews Phase 1 which supports the consultation documents and provides the complete detail of the travel impact of the possible service models and solutions put forward for consultation and consideration.
- 2.3 Finally attached at **Appendix 3** is a briefing note from Integrated Transport Planning Limited (ITP) which sets out the assumptions and settings that have been applied in the preparation of the various documents.

3. CURRENT POSITION

- 3.1 The Path to Excellence consultation was launched in early July and a number of issues have been raised around the travel and transport aspects of the consultation. The Joint Health Scrutiny Committee has requested a dedicated meeting to look at this issue of transport and travel in relation to the first phase of the Path to Excellence consultation.

4. RECOMMENDATION

- 4.1 The Joint Health Scrutiny Coordinating Committee is recommended to consider and comment on the information provided by the ITP and the various transport and travel impact assessment documentation.
