# INTEGRATED CARE SYSTEM: APPROACH TO PLACE BASED PARTNERSHIP ARRANGEMENTS

#### **1.0** Purpose of the Report

- 1.1 The purpose of the report is to seek the views of this Committee on a report of the Executive Director of Public Health and Integrated Commissioning and Executive Director of Corporate Services (copy attached).
- 1.2 Members' views are requested on the proposed approach to partnership arrangements to integrate Health and Care in Sunderland in readiness for the establishment of the Integrated Care System as a statutory body from 01 April 2022.

#### 2.0 Background and Current Position

- 2.1 The Cabinet, at its meeting on 11<sup>th</sup> January 2022, will give consideration to the future of place-based partnership arrangements.
- 2.2 The report recommends the Cabinet to:
  - a. approve the approach to formalise Sunderland's place-based partnership arrangements as set out in the report; and
  - b. authorise the Chief Executive, in consultation with the Leader of the Council, the Executive Director of Public Health and Integrated Commissioning and the Executive Director of Corporate Services, to approve the Place Based Agreement that would underpin the collaborative working arrangements described in this report, once finalised.
- 2.3 The Governing Body of Sunderland Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG), at its meeting on 11th January 2022, will receive the same report for consideration. The CCG Governing Body will be asked to approve the approach to formalise Sunderland's place-based partnership arrangements.

#### 3.0 Conclusion

3.1 The report is referred to the Scrutiny Committee for consideration and comment. The comments from the Health and Wellbeing Scrutiny Committee will be reported verbally to Cabinet and Sunderland CCG Governing Body on 11 January 2022.
