ACTIVITIES FOR THE FORTHCOMING YEAR

Report of the Chief Solicitor

1. Introduction

The purpose of this report is to seek the Committee's views on the scope of its activities for the forthcoming civic year.

2. Current Position

In addition to discharging its legal responsibilities the Committee has a broader role of promoting and maintaining high standards of conduct of Members of the City Council and Hetton Town Council. Whilst it is difficult to timetable a work plan for the forthcoming year because of uncertainties as to when or whether the Government proposes to amend the current Code of Conduct, the Committee is invited to consider the following activities proposed to be undertaken:-

- Induction training for new members on the Code of Conduct held on 12 May 2010.
- To consider and make recommendations to Council on possible changes to the Code of Conduct.
- Training of Members on any changes made to the Code of Conduct.
- Further refresher training for Members on the Code of Conduct.
- Further awareness raising and communication of the importance of the ethical agenda with officers and the public including the enhancement of the information on the Council's web-site.
- Appropriate attendance at the Standards Board's conference and feedback.
- Continued update of significant issues to members.
- Occasional meetings of the Chairman with Leaders of the political groups of the Council.
- Continued networking with Chairs of other Standards Committees.
- Submission of an annual report to full Council.
