

WASTE MANAGEMENT – ANCILLARY PROCUREMENTS

REPORT OF THE CITY SOLICITOR

1. Why has this report come to the Committee?

- 1.1 To consider the report of the Director of Community and Cultural Services which will be considered by Cabinet on 14 January 2009.
- 1.2 The Chairman has requested that this item be included on the agenda in order to allow the Committee to monitor the progress being made on the Joint Municipal Waste Management Strategy.

2. Background

- 2.1 On 14 January 2009, the Cabinet will consider the attached report and are recommended to:-
 - i. Approve amendments to the proposed contract periods to provide for an interim of 3 years (prior to the award of contracts for periods of 10 years as previously approved) for:
 - a) recycling of dry recyclables (Materials Recycling facility); and
 - b) green waste recycling (without food waste); and
 - ii. agree to procure necessary landfill arrangements for an initial period of 3 years;
 - iii. agree that all proposed contracts allow for a series of up to three one year extensions beyond the initial contract term in order that arrangements and facilities will be available in the event of any delays in the commissioning of strategic sub-regional waste treatment facilities
 - iv. approve a competitive tendering exercise in respect of the proposed contracts.

3. Recommendation

- 3.1 The Committee is requested to consider and note the report of the Director of Community and Cultural Services which will be considered by Cabinet on 14 January 2009.
