

Covid-19 - Do's and Don'ts For Council Meeting Attendees

Do

- Take a rapid lateral flow test prior to attending the meeting (tests will be available at the venue if you don't have access to them).
- Attendees are also strongly recommended to ensure they are fully vaccinated.
- Sanitise hands on arrival and use hand sanitiser regularly.
- On arrival move swiftly to the main hall downstairs – staff will be in place to direct you.
- Wear a face covering (unless you are exempt).
- Keep apart from others, maintain a 2 metre distance. The seats in the venue will be arranged to afford appropriate distancing.
- Wear warm clothing as the air handling system will be on full throughout the meeting.
- Follow the one-way system in place.
- Only sit in your designated seat and refrain from standing conversations.

Do Not

- Attend if you are unwell, self-isolating or have recently had a positive Covid test.
- Attend if you have COVID-19 symptoms. You should self-isolate immediately if you show any symptoms of COVID-19 and book a PCR test as soon as possible, even if you are fully vaccinated
- Enter the venue without applying a face covering first.
- Forget to regularly wash your hands or use sanitiser.
- Move within 2 metres of another person.
- Share any items such as pens/pencils or touch anything you don't have to.
